Gates will open 2 hours before match start.

The following information will help you plan your travel to Trent Bridge, Nottingham and offer transport tips around Nottingham to make your visit as enjoyable as possible.

- Plan both your journey to and from the ground and purchase your train tickets or parking in advance.
- Allow enough time for your journey and getting to the ground, the surrounding area can get extremely busy near the start of the match.
- If you plan to travel by car, please also check www.trafficengland.com to make sure the planned roadworks do not affect your planned route.

Trent Bridge is located one mile from Nottingham Train Station and approximately 1.5 miles from Nottingham city centre.

GETTING TO TRENT BRIDGE



... BY CAR - VENUE PARKING

There is no official match day parking available through the ground. However, there is a large parking area at Victoria Embankment which has space for up to 2,000 cars which is 0.7 miles from the ground.



... PARK & RIDE (TRAM)

Nottingham Express Transit (NET) operate the Tram network and they offer a number of excellent Park & Ride sites around Nottinghamshire. There are two sites which are recommended:



- Clifton South Park & Ride (NG11 8BF) – 1,000+ spaces and a 20 minute tram to Nottingham station or alight at Meadows Embankment for a 1 mile walk along the River Trent to Trent Bridge
- Toton Lane Park & Ride (NG9 7JA) – 1,400+ spaces and a 28 minute tram to Nottingham station

... BY BUS

Trent Bridge is easily accessible by bus and the following services provide a frequent link between the city centre, Nottingham station and the ground:

- NCT Green Line Services – 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 9B, 10, 10C, 10X, and
- NCT Navy Line Services – 1, 3
- Trent Barton Mainline (Nottingham – Trent Bridge – West Bridgford – Radcliffe – Bingham)

NCT services from Nottingham City Centre and Nottingham Station will be free of charge for ticket holders.

All of the buses which operate between Nottingham station and Trent Bridge are low floored accessible buses. The buses which stop along Bridgford Road provide the easiest and most direct route to the ground.

... BY TRAIN

Nottingham train station is the closest to the ground and is well served by local, regional and national services including London, Sheffield, Birmingham and Manchester.

There is a tram stop located at the very top of the train station which provides a direct link around and into the city centre.

If it is your first time to Nottingham station, we recommend you follow signs to Carrington Street which will lead you to the station's ticket hall and our World Cup Cricketers who will help answer any questions and guide you to the ground.

Nottingham station is an accessible station and if you do require assistance please make this known with your rail operator so they can ensure that you have a safe and comfortable journey.

... BY ACTIVE TRAVEL



WALK Trent Bridge is located in the borough of West Bridgford which is 1 mile from Nottingham station, and 1.5 miles from Nottingham city centre. Our World Cup Cricketers be there and will cheer you on the way to the ground!



CYCLE At present there is no cycle parking at Trent Bridge. The nearest secure cycle parking is located at the West Bridgford Library.



... DROP OFF & PICK UP / TAXI, PRIVATE HIRE, UBER

There is no official drop off and pickup location. It is recommended to avoid driving near the venue on a match day due to the extra congestion and activity associated with the match. There are safe places to drop off and pick up in West Bridgford which is 400m from the ground.



... TRAVEL OPTIONS IF YOU HAVE ACCESSIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

BLUE BADGE PARKING There are a limited number of blue badge parking spaces available which are booked on a first come, first serve basis. These can be booked directly with Trent Bridge Cricket Ground by phoning 0115 982 3000.

PUBLIC BUSES All of the buses which operate between Nottingham station and Trent Bridge are accessible buses. The buses which stop along Bridgford Road provide the easiest and most direct route to the ground.

RAIL All rail operators in the UK will be able to provide additional support to those with limited or reduced mobility. Nottingham station has a number of lifts available to move spectators from platform level to the main concourse.
