Each committee member serves a 3-year tenure and can choose to stand to be re-elected or re-appointed up to 3 times. This means that we annually have vacancies arising on the General Committee and the Nominations Panel's role is to lead the process of appointing candidates to the General Committee.

In this volunteer role you'll be responsible for reviewing the current skills and experience of the General Committee to determine the requirements of future candidates; ensuring a diverse mix of knowledge, experience and thinking styles for continued success.

What you'll be doing:

- Collaborating with fellow panel members and the General Committee to understand the skills and competencies required to fill any vacancies.
- Support the development and implementation of effective recruitment processes.
- Develop options and methods for recruitment using a range of channels in conjunction with the club.
- Prepare for and attend all meetings of the panel, reading candidate applications and other relevant reports in advance.
- Participate in interview and assessment processes with candidates.
- Contribute to and share responsibility for the decisions of the panel.
- Ensure candidates appointed or recommended for election meet the club's integrity criteria and have the best interests of Nottinghamshire County Cricket Club at heart.

- Have extensive experience in undertaking interviews
- Have worked effectively with a range of stakeholders and have confidence in working with people at all levels.
- Demonstrate excellent communication skills with the ability to draw out information accurately, clearly and concisely
- Appreciate the value of diversity of people and how their range of experiences are important for success.
- Be decisive, making effective decisions and leading by example
- Have the ability to build positive relationships, working collaboratively with others in an engaging and inspiring way.
